# God's Medicine

## For the Heart

Divine healing in our redemption must become a settled fact in our heart for us to receive divine healing. These scriptures from God's Word will give you evidence that it is God's will to heal you. In fact, God has already provided and paid for your healing.

### **Proverbs 4:20-22**

**“[20] My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. [21] Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. [22] For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.” - KJ**

God's Word is health to your flesh!

The Hebrew word for health is *marpe*. The Hebrew word *marpe* is also translated CURE, HEALING, HEALTH, REMEDY, SOUND, MEDICINE.

God's Word is medicine and health, a cure, to make us sound and healed!

### **Psalm 107:20**

**“He sent His Word and healed them...” - KJ**

Jesus was the Word made flesh (John 1:14). He was the perfect example of what the Word of God will do. Jesus never refused to heal anyone that came to him. Coming to the Word of God is just like coming to Jesus. The Word will never refuse you.

The Word is medicine to all our flesh. God's Medicine (His Word) is just like medicine prescribed by a doctor; it must be taken internally for it to affect a cure.

## **How do I take God's Medicine?**

I put the Word of God in my mouth.

### **Proverbs 12:18**

**"...the tongue of the wise is health." - KJ**

### **Proverbs 18:21**

**"Death and life are in the power of the tongue..." - KJ**

In the parable of the sower (Mark 4:14) Jesus tells us the Word of God is seed. The law of seed is that seed has the ability to reproduce itself. God's Word has the ability to reproduce itself in you!

You plant God's seed (His Word) with your mouth. The Word planted will penetrate your spirit. Your spirit sends the Divine Healing Power of God to the part of your body that needs it. It will cause healing to come to your heart, blood and arteries!

### **Romans 8:11**

**"He who raised the Messiah Jesus from the dead will thrill with a new life your very bodies – those mortal bodies of yours – by the Agency of his own Spirit, which now has its home in you." - WAY**

Take God's medicine and the Holy Spirit will take the Word and send it to the part of your body that needs life. Life destroys sickness and disease. Life heals the circulatory system.

### **This Is How I Take God's Medicine:**

First, I find the healing scriptures that mean something special to me. Like...

### **Psalm 103:2, 3**

**"[2] Bless the Lord O my soul, and forget not all his benefits; [3] who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases." - KJ**

Then, I read the scripture over and over many times. I will continue to read it until I have a clear understanding of what that scripture is saying to me personally. I will begin to think about the scripture and what God is saying to me through it. I will analyze, ponder and take the scripture apart in my mind.

Finally, I will mutter the scripture to myself **out loud** (I'll talk it to myself).

**EXAMPLE - How I take God's Medicine (with my mouth & out loud):**

*"I bless you Lord with all my soul – I thank You for ALL your benefits – You have forgiven ALL my iniquities and all my sin, and healed ALL, ALL, ALL my diseases. I thank You Father, that You sent Your Word to heal. Your Word says you heal ALL my diseases. I thank You, Father, Your Word is causing health to come to my physical body. I thank You, Father, that healing is a benefit of our covenant. I will not forget your benefits, you forgave my sin and healed my diseases!"*

I repeat this process of taking God's medicine until the healing is totally complete.

**DO NOT TAKE ONE DOSE AND QUIT!** (You cannot O.D. on the Word)

Find the scriptures that mean something special to you. Follow the directions on taking "God's Medicine", and then give it time to work!

**YOUR HEART HAS NO CHOICE; IT MUST RESPOND TO THE WORD!!!**

**IT ALWAYS WORKS WHEN YOU TAKE YOUR MEDICINE.**

# Healing Scriptures for the Heart

## Deuteronomy 28:4

**“Blessed shall be the fruit of thy body.” – KJ**

Blessed is the fruit of thy womb. – YLT

The Lord will bless you with healthy children. – CW

**NOTE:** All hereditary diseases are done away with (such as congenital heart diseases and defects)! Your children are God blessed and healthy children!!

*These Curses Christ Has Redeemed Us From  
(See Galatians 3:13, page 31)*

## Deuteronomy 28:22, 61, 65

**“[22] The Lord shall smite thee with a consumption, and with a fever, and with an inflammation, and with an extreme burning, and with the sword, and with blasting, and with mildew; and they shall pursue thee until thou perish. [59] Then the Lord will make thy plagues wonderful, and the plagues of thy seed, even great plagues, and of long continuance, and sore sicknesses, and of long continuance. [61] Also every sickness, and every plague, which is not written in the book of this law...[65]And among those nations you shall find no rest, nor shall the sole of your foot have a resting place; but there the Lord will give you a trembling heart, failing eyes, and anguish of soul.” – KJ**

### Verse 22, Consumption:

*All chronic diseases - (Matthew Henry's Commentary)*

**NOTE:** This includes all forms of chronic ischemic heart disease.

...Infectious diseases – GN

...Wasting disease – **NEB**

...Shingles – **FRESH**

### **Verse 22, Inflammation:**

**NOTE:** You have been redeemed from heart diseases caused by inflammation! You are redeemed from Kawasaki's Disease (inflammation of the arteries), Pericarditis (the inflammation of the pericardium, the thin sac (or membrane) that surrounds the heart) and from vein inflammation (or Thrombophlebitis)!!

#### *All acute diseases - (Matthew Henry's Commentary)*

**NOTE:** This includes acute myocardial infarction and other acute ischemic (coronary) heart diseases.

...Swelling – **NCV**

**NOTE:** An aneurysm is an abnormal (often balloon-like) swelling on the side of an artery caused by a weakness in the arterial wall. An aneurysm involves either the swelling or rupturing of blood vessels, therefore, we have been redeemed from aneurysms!!

Also, varicose veins (or Hemorrhoids) involve a swelling of blood vessel walls. In fact they are a form of aneurysm. Therefore, we are also delivered from varicose veins!!

### **Verse 59, Plagues & Sore Sickesses:**

...Malignant and obstinate diseases – **BYING**

...Incurable diseases and horrible epidemics – **GN**

...Severe & lasting plagues, miserable & chronic sicknesses - **NASB**

...Cruel diseases stretching on through long years – **BASIC**

...Hideous interminable illnesses – **MESS**

...Severe and lingering diseases – **GW**

...Infirmities grievous and perpetual – **DOUAY**

...Sicknesses evil and lasting – **FOX**

...Strokes – **YLT**

**NOTE:** Strokes are the result of clogging of blood vessels so that the brain tissue is blood-starved and this is known as cerebrovascular insufficiency. Therefore, we are redeemed from clogged blood vessels & arteries because we are redeemed from strokes!!

**Verse 61:**

...Any kind of sickness or calamity not mentioned in this Book of the Law – **NAB**

...All of the other kinds of sickness and trouble I haven't written down – **NIRV**

**Verse 65, Trembling heart:**

...a quaking heart – **JERU**

...a shaking heart – **BASIC**

...a shuddering heart – **FOX**

**NOTE:** This means that heart arrhythmias (disorders of heart rhythm) are under the curse!

**Galatians 3:13:** “The law put a curse on us, but Christ took away that curse!!” – **DEAF**. *We are redeemed from the curse of a trembling heart!!!*

**Deuteronomy 34:7**

**“And Moses was an hundred and twenty years old when he died: his eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated.” – KJ**

...his eyesight never became poor, and he never lost his physical strength. – **GW**



...Moses was still in possession of all his faculties when he died, and his eye was clear. – **FRESH**

...his eyesight was sharp; he still walked with a spring in his step. – **MESS**

...he was as strong as a young man. – **LB**

**Psalm 22:26**

**“The meek shall eat and be satisfied: they shall praise the Lord that seek him: your heart shall live for ever.” – KJ**

Those who seek Yahweh will praise him. Long life to their hearts! – **JERU**

...good heart for ever. – **NEB**

**Psalm 31:24**

**“Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the Lord.” – KJ**

Be brave. Be strong. Don't give up. Expect God to get here soon. – **MESS**

Put away fear and let your heart be strong, all you whose hope is in the Lord. – **BASIC**

Trust in the Lord and take courage...He will strengthen your heart... - **CW**

So cheer up! Take courage if you are depending on the Lord! – **LB**

...may your heart be strong... - **NW**

**Psalm 51:10**

**“Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.” – KJ**

...a pure heart... - **GN**

...a new, clean heart... - **LB**

Give me a clean bill of health. God, make a fresh start in me, shape a Genesis week from the chaos of my life. – **MESS**

**Psalm 57:7**

**“My heart is fixed, O God, my heart is fixed: I will sing and give praise.” – KJ**

My heart is steady, God, my heart is steady. I will sing and praise you. – **NCV**

My heart feels secure... - **NIRV**

My own heart is at peace, for I praise the name of the Lord. – **FRESH**

**Psalm 69:32**

**“...Your heart shall live that seek God.” – KJ**

...The hearts of those who worship God will be strengthened. – **NIRV**

...your heart will be restored who inquire of Elohim. – **URIM**

...long life to your hearts, all you who seek for God. – **JERU**

...lovers of God, let your hearts have life. – **BASIC**

...you who seek God, let your heart revive! – **GSPD**

... God-seeking hearts will revive. – **GRAIL**

**Psalm 73:26**

**“My flesh and my heart faileth: but God is the strength of my heart, and my portion for ever.” – KJ**

My body and my heart may grow weak. God, you give strength to my heart. You are everything I will ever need. – **NIRV**

My flesh and my heart fail; but my hearts rock and my portion is God forever. – **GSPD**

My flesh and my heart may grow weak, but God always protects my heart and gives me stability. – **NET**

My health fails; my spirit droop, yet God remains! He is the strength of my heart; he is mine forever! – **LB**

You are all I have, Lord. I am depending entirely upon you. My flesh and my courage are at a low ebb, but you come on strong as the strength of my life. – **FRESH**

...you are my strength. All I really need is you. – **CW**

**Psalm 103:2-3**

**“[2] Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: [3] who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases.” – KJ**

My whole being, praise the Lord... - **NCV**

O my soul, bless God, don't forget a single blessing! He forgives your sins – every one. He heals your diseases – every one. – **MESS**

He pardons all my guilt and heals all my suffering. – **NEB**

...he takes away all your diseases. – **BASIC**

...heals all thy mortal ills. – **KNOX**

...who is healing all thy diseases. – **YLT**

...curing all your diseases. – **JERU**

...He heals all my sicknesses and saves my life from being destroyed. – **BECK**

[2-5] ...Never forget all that God has done for us. God forgives errors, he heals diseases, he equips believers in loving-kindness and tender mercies, he makes food taste good, and refreshes a person so that even the advanced in years feel young and spry and seek to fly like eagles. – **FRESH**

#### **Psalm 104:15**

**“He causes...bread which strengtheneth man's heart.” – KJ**

...bread to strengthen human hearts. – **GW**

...bread -- the heart of man it supporteth. – **YLT**

...food that sustains people's lives. – **NET**

...food that strengthens man's inner parts. – **URIM**

...bread that sustains the very heart of mortal man. – **NW**

...Their faces glowing with health, a people well-fed (properly fed) and hearty. – **MESS**

#### **Psalm 112:7-8**

**“[7] He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the Lord. [8] His heart is established, he shall not be afraid. – KJ**

He is not afraid of receiving bad news; his faith is strong, and he trusts in the Lord... - **GN**

He shall not worry over bad news, for he trust in the Lord... -  
**FRESH**

They aren't afraid when bad news comes. They stand firm because they trust in the Lord. Their hearts are secure. They aren't afraid. – **NIRV**

His faith is not shaken by bad news because his heart is fixed on God, and he trusts all things to the Lord. He feels secure and unafraid... - **CW**

He does not fear bad news, nor live in dread of what may happen. For he is settled in his mind that Jehovah will take care of him. That is why he is not afraid but can calmly face his foes. – **LB**

...he will look triumphantly at his enemies. – **GW**

### **Psalm 147:3**

**“He healeth the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds.” – KJ**

Healing He brings to the broken-hearted. – **WAY**

He heals the heartbroken... - **MESS**

He has healed the broken-hearted, he has relieved the wounded.  
– **FRESH**

...He is healing the brokenhearted ones, and is binding up their painful spots. – **NW**

...and binds up the wounds of those who are hurt. – **CW**

### Proverbs 4:20-23

**“[20] My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. [21] Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. [22] For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh. [23] Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.” - KJ**

#### **Verse 21:**

Keep my message in plain view at all times. Concentrate!  
Learn it by heart! – **MESS**

...let them penetrate deep within your heart. – **LB**

#### **Verse 22:**

Those who discover these words live, really live; body and soul,  
they're bursting with health. – **MESS**

They are life to those who find them and they heal the whole  
body. – **GW**

...to every part of one's flesh they bring healing. – **RHM**

...let a man master them, they will bring life and healing to his  
whole being. – **KNOX**

...and to all his body a healing. – **LEESER**

...health for the entire body. – **JERU**

...they will mean real life for you and radiant health. – **LB**

...My Words...health to all parts of the frame. – **FENTON**

#### **Verse 23:**

The most important thing is for you to be careful in the things  
you think. Your thoughts control your life. – **ETR**

...guard the affections of your heart; the emotional attachments you make determine the course of your life. – **CW**

Be careful how you think; your life is shaped by your thoughts. – **GN**

### **Proverbs 13:12**

**“Hope deferred maketh the heart sick: but when the desire cometh, it is a tree of life.” – KJ**

When hope is crushed, the heart is crushed, but a wish come true fills you with joy. – **GN**

Hope that is put off makes one sick at heart. But a longing that is met is like a tree of life. – **NIRV**

Hope prolonged is making the heart sick, and a tree of life [is] the coming desire. – **YLT**

If there is no hope, then the heart is sad... - **ETR**

### **Proverbs 14:30**

**“A sound heart is the life of the flesh: but envy the rottenness of the bones.” – KJ**

A relaxed attitude lengthens a man’s life... – **LB**

A calm heart is the life of the fleshly organism... - **NW**

A healed heart [is] life to the flesh, and rottenness to the bones [is] envy. – **YLT**

A heart full of peace gives life to the body, but envy and jealousy rot the bones. – **CW**

If a person has peace in his mind, then his body will be healthy. But jealousy causes sickness in his body. – **ETR**

Peace of mind makes the body healthy, but jealousy is like a cancer. – **GN**

A sound mind makes for a robust body, but runaway emotions corrode... - **MESS**

### **Proverbs 17:22**

**“A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones.” – KJ**

A glad heart is excellent medicine, a spirit depressed wastes the bones away. – **JERU**

A cheerful heart makes a quick recovery; it is crushed spirits that waste a man’s frame. – **KNOX**

A joyful attitude is real good medicine, while a gloomy spirit makes your bones ache. – **FRESH**

A joyful heart is good medicine, but depression drains one’s strength. – **GW**

Happiness is like good medicine. But sorrow is like a sickness. – **ETR**

Being cheerful keeps you healthy... – **GN**

A happy heart is a healing medicine... – **GSPD**

A glad heart makes a healthy body... – **BASIC**

A glad heart helps and heals... - **MOFF**

The best medicine is a cheerful heart... – **FENTON**



A joyful heart worketh an excellent cure... – **RHM**

...a broken spirit makes one sick. – **LB**

...but low spirits sap a man's strength. – **NEB**

**Jeremiah 30:17**

**“I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the Lord...” - KJ**

I will make you well again... - **GN**

I will make you healthy again... - **NIRV**

I will cause new skin to grow and heal your wounds, says the Lord. – **NEB**

I will bring back your health and heal your injuries. – **NCV**

I will restore you to health; of your wounds I will heal you. – **NAB**

For you, I will come with healing, curing the incurable... - **MESS**

**Jeremiah 32:27**

**“Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh: is there any thing too hard for me?” – KJ**

Jeremiah, I am the Lord. I am the God of every person on the earth. Jeremiah, you know that nothing is impossible for me. – **ETR**

I am the Lord God of all humanity. Nothing is too hard for me. – **GW**

...Is there anything I can't do? – **MESS**

There is nothing too difficult or impossible with me. – **FRESH**

**Ezekiel 11:19**

**“And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and will give them an heart of flesh:” – KJ**

I'll give you a new heart. I'll put a new spirit in you. I'll cut out your stone heart and replace it with a red-blooded, firm-muscled heart. – **MESS**

...I will put a real heart in its place. – **ETR**

**Ezekiel 16:6**

**“And when I passed by thee, and saw thee polluted in thine own blood, I said unto thee when thou wast in thy blood, Live; yea, I said unto thee when thou wast in thy blood, Live.” – KJ**

I saw you struggling in your blood... - **JERU**

...I proceeded to say to you in your blood, “Keep Living!” yes, to say to you in your blood, “Keep Living!” – **NW**

I came by and saw you there...I said, “Live! Thrive like a plant in the field!” and you did! – **LB**

**Ezekiel 36:26**

**“A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you a heart of flesh.” – KJ**

I'll give you a new heart, put a new spirit in you. I'll remove the stone heart from your body and replace it... - **MESS**

...I shall remove the heart of stone from your bodies and give you a heart of flesh instead. – **JERU**

...give you a tender, human heart. – **ETR**

**Joel 3:21**

**“For I will cleanse their blood that I have not cleansed: for the Lord dwelleth in Zion.” – KJ**

The children of God, such as those of Judah who have been faithful, and the believers everywhere, from Jerusalem to the farthest corners of the earth, will be cleansed by the blood, and God shall surely dwell with His people forever. – **FRESH**

**Mark 5:25-34**

**“[25] And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years, [26] and had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse, [27] when she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his garment. [28] For she said, “If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole.” [29] And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague. [30] And Jesus, immediately knowing in himself that virtue had gone out of him, turned him about in the press, and said, who touched my clothes? [31] And his disciples said unto him, Thou seest the multitude thronging thee, and sayest thou, Who touched me? [32] And he looked round about to see her that had done this thing. [33] But the woman fearing and trembling, knowing what was done in her, came and fell down before him. And told him all the truth. [34] And he said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.” - KJ**

**Verse 25:**

There was a woman who suffered terrible from severe bleeding for twelve years. – **TEV**

...who had a hemorrhage for twelve years. – **PHI**

...a menstrual problem for twelve years. – **JOHN**

...a circulatory problem... - **FRESH**

**Verse 26:**

She had undergone many different kinds of treatment at the hands of many doctors. She had spent her last penny trying to find a cure. It had done her no good at all. Indeed her trouble grew worse and worse. – **BAR**

Who had gone through a great deal at the hands of many doctors, spending all her money in the process. She had derived no benefit from them but, on the contrary, was getting worse. – **PHI**

A long succession of physicians had treated her, and treated her badly, taking all her money and leaving her worse off than before. – **MESS**

She had suffered a great deal thru many treatments under various doctors... - **LM**

She had gone to many doctors, and they had not done anything except cause her a lot of pain... - **CEV**

In spite of long treatment by many doctors, on which she had spent all she had, there had been no improvement... - **NEB**

...She got worse all the time. – **TEV**

**Verse 27:**

She had heard the reports concerning Jesus, and she came up behind Him in the throng and touched His garment. – **AMP**

She had heard all about the wonderful miracles Jesus did, and that is why she came up behind him through the crowd and touched his clothes. – **LB**

The woman had heard of Jesus' healing ministry... - **JOHN**

**Verse 28:**

“If I can only touch his clothes,” she kept saying, “I shall be all right.” – **PHI**

The woman thought, “If I can touch his clothes that will be enough to heal me.” – **ETR**

She had convinced herself... - **JOHN**

Because she had kept saying to herself, “If I can just touch His clothes, I'll get well.” – **LM**

She was thinking to herself, “If I can put a finger on his robe, I can get well.” – **MESS**

**Verse 29:**

And immediately her flow of blood was dried up at the source, and [suddenly] she felt in her body that she was healed of her [distressing] ailment. – **AMP**

And sure enough, as soon as she had touched him, the bleeding stopped and she knew she was well! – **LB**

And the source of the bleeding dried up instantly, and she felt in herself that she was cured of her complaint. – **JERU**

The moment she did it, the flow of blood dried up. She could feel the change, and knew her plague was over and done with. – **MESS**

...and was at that moment in a state of health. – **WUEST**

**Verse 30:**

Jesus was aware that his power had gone out of him. Immediately he swung round in the crowd... - **BAR**

Instantly, too, Jesus, knowing his healing power had been active, turned round in the crowd and asked... - **K&L**

At the same moment, Jesus felt energy discharging from him... - **MESS**

Jesus realized at once that healing power had gone out from him... - **NLT**

Jesus also was immediately aware that power within Him had been drawn from him... - **AUTH**

Jesus, becoming conscious that the healing power within Him had been in active operation... - **WADE**

Jesus instantly became conscious that there had been a demand upon his powers... - **20C**

At once Jesus knew intuitively that power had gone out of him... - **PHI**

Jesus instantly perceived that healing power had passed from him... - **GSPD**

Jesus felt the loss of power or the extension of goodness that had left him... - **FRESH**

**Verse 33:**

Then the woman came forward, nervous and shy... - **VERNON**

The woman was so scared that she was still shaking. She knew what had happened to her. So she came and threw herself at Jesus' feet, and told him the whole truth. – **BAR**

Then the frightened woman, trembling at the realization of what had happened to her, came and fell at his feet and told him what she had done. – **NLT**

The woman knew that she was healed. So she came and bowed at Jesus' feet... - **ETR**

**Verse 34:**

'Daughter,' he said, 'your faith has cured you. Go and God bless you! Go and enjoy your new health, free from the trouble that was your scourge.' – **BAR**

Jesus said to the woman, "Dear woman, you are made well because you believed. Go in peace. You will have no more suffering. – **ETR**

Jesus said to her, "Daughter, you took a risk of faith, and now you're healed and whole. Live well, live blessed! Be healed of your plague." – **MESS**

And He said to her, Daughter, your faith (your trust and confidence in Me, springing from faith in God) has restored you to health. Go in (into) peace and be continually healed and freed from your [distressing bodily] disease. – **AMP**

Jesus said to the woman, "You are now well because of your faith. May God give you peace! You are healed, and you will no longer be in pain." – **CEV**

...“May you go back home to happier days and may your illness trouble you no more!” – **VERNON**

...be entirely free from thy disease. – **EDW**

**Mark 9:23**

**“Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.” - KJ**

Jesus said to the father, “It’s not a question of if I can”... - **CW**

...everything is possible for one who has faith. – **GSPD**

...anything can be done for one who believes. – **MOFF**

...anything can happen if you can believe. – **JOHN**

And Jesus said, “(You say to me) If You can do anything? (Why), all things can be (are possible) to him who believes!” – **AMP**

And Jesus said to him, "If you can.' [Note: By repeating the man's words Jesus seems to be saying, "You mean, if YOU can believe"]. Everything is possible to the person who believes [it can happen]." – **UNDER**

Jesus said, “If? There are no ‘ifs’ among believers, Anything can happen.” – **MESS**

Jesus replied, “What’s this ‘if’ business? Anything is possible when you trust me.” – **AUSSIE**

...“As to that ‘if you can do anything,’ one who believes can do everything!” – **K&L**



**Luke 4:18**

**“The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised.” – KJ**

...I mend broken hearts... - **DIST**

...to heal those with broken hearts... - **CW**

**Luke 21:26**

**“Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth.” – KJ**

The hearts of men will give up because of being afraid... - **NL**

Many will die of heart failure because of being terror-stricken...  
- **LM**

**NOTE:** In the textbook “Principles of Anatomy and Physiology” under the section entitled “Blood Supply” states that most heart problems result from faulty coronary circulation. The information continues to state that stress (fear & anxiety) which produces constriction of vessel walls is a common cause. That is why Proverbs 17:22 (page 16) is so important!

**John 14:1**

**“Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.” – KJ**

Let not your heart continue to be agitated. Be putting your trust in God. Also be putting your trust in me. – **WUEST**

Do not let your heart be troubled! You have faith in God... -  
**K&L**

...you are trusting God... - **LB**

Don't let this throw you. You trust God, don't you? – **MESS**

**John 14:12-14**

**“[12] Verily, verily, I say unto you, he that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do because I go unto my Father. [13] And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. [14] If ye shall ask anything in my name, I will do it.” – KJ**

Anyone who trusts me and supports the works that I do shall have the opportunity of doing works of their own, even greater than the works I have been doing as illustrations. I am going to the Father. I'll be right there in the throne room, and the things you ask of God sincerely in my name, I will get it done for the glory of God. There is no limit placed on this prayerful arrangement. – **FRESH**

I tell you a positive fact... - **AUTH**

I can guarantee this truth... - **GW**

...whoever believes in Me will have the power to do the same deeds that I do, and even greater... - **GREBER**

...He that exercises faith in me, that one also will do the works that I do. – **NW**

...whoever puts his trust in Me can do the things I am doing...so the shining greatness of the Father may be seen... - **NL**

...I will grant anything you ask me for as my followers. – **GSPD**

...I want everyone to realize how much God cares about them, so don't hesitate to ask me for help. – **BLB**

**Acts 15:9**

**“...Purifying their hearts by faith.” – KJ**

...cleansed their hearts by faith. – **K&L**

...When they believed, he made their hearts pure. – **NCV**

...in answer to their faith...cleansed their hearts. – **WUEST**

...they had their hearts made clean when they put their trust in Him. – **NL**

...he had removed all the uncleanness from their hearts when he gave them faith. – **KNOX**

**Romans 5:5**

**“And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.” – KJ**

This hope never lets us down... - **BAR**

...because God’s love has flooded our inmost heart through the Holy Spirit he has given us. – **NEB**

This is a hope which never disappoints us because it rises from a sense of God’s love for us poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit... - **HUDSON**

Toughness makes for reliability and reliability for confidence, and confidence doesn’t let you down. For God has given us a love transfusion by the Holy Spirit he provided for us. While we were real sick, in the nick of time Christ died for people. – **CP**

This hope of glory will not deceive and thus put us to shame; because the love of God has been shed abroad in our hearts, through the Holy Ghost which was given to us, when we

became Christians, and is our security that our hope is not vain, but that God will fulfill it. – **GEIKIE**

This hope is no mere illusion, since a consciousness of the love of God to us is shed abroad in our hearts... - **PILCHER**

### **Romans 8:2**

**“For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.” - KJ**

For the new spiritual principle of life “in” Christ Jesus lifts me out of the old vicious circle of sin and death. – **PHI**

For the law of the Spirit, which breathes a life absorbed into that of the messiah Jesus, has emancipated me from the law of sin, of death. – **WAY**

For the laws governing the spirit-world that lives in communion with Christ Jesus have freed me from the law governing the realm of the spiritually dead. – **GREBER**

This result is attained by establishing in man the inner dominion of the Spirit, which overthrows that of the flesh... - **STVNS**

Another law, not that of sin, not even that of Moses, has released them, unfettered them, disenthralled them. Another law, do I say? I don't know why I call it a law. It is liberty. The words of Christ are spirit and are life. Christ has said, “Go free.” The reign of sin is over, and the fear of death is gone! – **CARP**

Everything works for persons who live so completely in Christ...The rules themselves were not impressive enough to do the job, and so Christ came that in him victory could be assured, and people could change from living by the rules and losing, to living by the spirit and winning. – **FRESH**

The power of the Holy Spirit has made me free from the power of sin and death. This power is mine because I belong to Christ. – **NL**

The Spirit has its own law, and this law gives me life in Christ Jesus... - **LAU**

The new rule of the living Spirit operating in believers has liberated you and me from that deadly grip of wrongdoing. – **FD**

The law of the Spirit, that of the life in Christ Jesus, freed you once for all from the law of the sinful nature and of death. – **WUEST**

For, when through union with Christ Jesus I came under the law of the life-giving spirit... - **BAR**

A new power is in operation. The Spirit of life in Christ...– **MESS**

...the life-giving law of the Spirit...– **GSPD**

...(the law of our new being)... - **AMP**

### **Romans 8:11**

**“But if the spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.” - KJ**

Nevertheless once the Spirit of Him who raised Christ Jesus from the dead lives within you He will, by the same Spirit, bring to your whole being new strength and vitality. – **PHI**

But if the Spirit of God, who raised up Jesus from the dead, lives in your hearts, [then] that One [i.e., God] who raised up

Christ Jesus from the dead, will restore life to your mortal bodies also, through [the power of] God's Spirit who lives in your hearts. – **UNDER**

Observe how He works within you just as He did when He raised Jesus from death to life. He is the divine functionary who will revolutionize your whole physical – psychological being! – **FD**

If the Spirit of God, of Him who raised Jesus from the dead, has its home in you, then He who raised the Messiah Jesus from the dead will thrill with a new life your very bodies – those mortal bodies of yours – by the agency of His own Spirit, which now has its home in you. – **WAY**

If the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead is dwelling in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also reanimate your mortal bodies through (or, because of) His Spirit who is dwelling in you. (Reanimate: to revive, resuscitate, or restore to life; to infuse new vigor or courage into.) – **BLACK**

If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead has taken possession of you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give your mortal bodies life through his spirit that has now taken possession of you. – **GSPD**

In fact, as you live in union with the Spirit of God, even your physical body will experience something like the resurrection of Jesus Christ. – **JOHN**

The Spirit of God who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you...It is His Spirit which lives in you which will be your life. – **LAU**

You live on a spiritual level if God's Spirit dwells in you... - **ABRV**

He will also impregnate your bodies...with the radiation of life.  
– **GREBER**

...will also create life in your mortal bodies... - **GODBEY**

...will also bring your mortal bodies back to life again, by means of His Spirit who lives in you. – **LM**

...Using His Spirit that lives in you. – **IEB**

### **Romans 10:8**

**“The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach.” – KJ**

What does it say...the word is close to thee, on thy lips, and in thine heart...the subject of our faith which we proclaim. – **WAY**

The word of salvation is already at hand. In fact, it's already in your hearts and your mouths. And what is that word? Why it's the very message we preach—salvation by faith. – **LOVETT**

In God's economy Jesus already died and has returned victoriously to life! So then, from the very moment one accepts this evidence and openly affirms Jesus sovereign is safe and sound! – **FD**

Salvation that comes from trusting Christ...it already within easy reach of us; in fact, it is as near as our own hearts and mouths. – **LB**

### **Galatians 3:13-14**

**“[13] Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the Law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, cursed is everyone that hangeth on a tree. [14] That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ...” - KJ**

[13] Christ redeemed us from that self-defeating, cursed life by absorbing it completely into himself. Do you remember the Scripture that says, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree”? That is what happened when Jesus was nailed to the Cross: He became a curse, and at the same time dissolved the curse. [14] And now, because of that, the air is cleared and we can see that Abraham’s blessing is present and available for non-Jews, too... - **MESS**

[13] But Christ has bought us out from under the doom of that impossible system by taking the curse for our wrongdoing upon himself. For it is written in the Scripture, “Anyone who is hanged on a tree is cursed” as Jesus was hung upon a wooden cross. [14] Now God can bless the Gentiles, too, with the same blessing he promised to Abraham... - **LB**

[13] The law put us under condemnation, but Christ took that condemnation away. He changed places with us; he put himself under that condemnation. It is written, “When a person’s body is hung on a tree, it shows that the person has been condemned.” [14] Christ did this, so that God’s promised blessing to Abraham could be given to all people... - **IEB**

[13] But Christ has freed us from the condemnation which is the inevitable outcome of trying and failing to keep rules as a way of life. He liberated us by accepting that condemnation for us, and experiencing it on the cross. [14] In so doing he annulled the rules so that the promise of God to Abraham might be received by outsiders... - **JOHN**

[13] But Christ saved us from the curse that came upon us for not perfectly obeying the Law. He did it by taking upon Himself the curse that was upon us... [14] So because of what Christ Jesus suffered for us on the cross, the blessing God promised Abraham is now available to everyone else as well... - **LM**



[13] Christ bought us back from the curse [caused by our not obeying all the requirements] of the law of Moses; He became a curse for us [by dying on the cross], for it is written [Deut. 21:23], "Everyone who hangs on a tree [i.e., a cross] is cursed [i.e., cut off from God]." [14] [This happened] so that the blessing [promised] to Abraham might be received by the Gentiles through [the person and work of] Christ. – **UNDER**

Christ ransomed us from the curse we inherited by our failure to keep the law, by becoming himself a very curse for us... – **WOOD**

Christ bought us with His blood and made us free from the Jewish Law. In that way, the Law could not punish us. Christ did this by carrying the load and by being punished instead of us... - **NL**

Jesus Christ rescued us from that trap by taking the damning we deserved by law...So you can take your pick; be damned yourself, or receive life from the damning Jesus got... – **STREET**

Christ, you see, redeemed us from the necessity of the minute observance of the law. Christ became accursed for our sake in order that we might avoid the curse of the law. – **FRESH**

The law put a curse on us, but Christ took away that curse. He changed places with us. Christ put Himself under that curse... – **DEAF**

Christ redeemed us from the curse threatened by the Law, when he became the object of a curse for us... - **K&L**

Christ it was who redeemed us from the curse of the law; by receiving our curse on His own person... – **HAYMAN**

Christ, at His own cost, delivered us from the curse of the Law, having for our sake submitted to its curse... - **WADE**

Christ by purchase released us from the curse of the law, He was cursed instead of us... - **NW**

Christ ransomed us from the curse pronounced in the law... - **20C**

...Christ has purchased our freedom... - **WEY**

#### **Philippians 4:7**

**“And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.” – KJ**

God’s peace be yours, that tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing...that peace which transcends all understanding, shall garrison and mount guard over your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. – **AMP**

God’s peace which operates beyond the range of human understanding, will protect your feelings and thought life in Christ Jesus. – **LOVETT**

Then the peace of God, which is greater than men can understand, will enfold your hearts and minds like a protecting wall in the power of Christ Jesus. – **GREBER**

The peace that God gives, the peace that transcends all conception, shall be the fortress – warder of your hearts... - **WAY**

And God’s peace, which is far beyond human understanding will keep your hearts and minds safe in union with Christ Jesus. – **GN**

### Colossians 1:12-13

**“[12] Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light. [13] Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son.” – KJ**

[12] And may you give joyful thanks to the Father who enabled you to be partners with enlightened Christians. [13] It was the Father who sprang us from the jailhouse of darkness, and turned us loose in the new world of his beloved Son, – **CP**

[12] And all the time you will give joyful thanks to the Father who has fitted you to receive a share of the heritage which belongs to the people of God in the realm of light. [13] In the realm of light, I say, for He has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of the Son whom He loves so dearly. – **BRUCE**

#### **Verse 12:**

Thank the Father who has entitled you to share the lot of God’s people in the realm of light. – **GSPD**

Give thanks to the Father. He has made you able to have the things he prepared for you. He has prepared these things for all his people who live in the light. – **ETR**

I pray that you will be giving thanks to the Father. He has made it so you could share the good things given to those who belong to Christ... - **NL**

With joy giving thanks to the Father having qualified [made fit, competent, adequate, sufficient] you for your part of the share of the saints in the light. – **TL**

...who had made us worthy... - **GODBEY**

...to share all the wonderful things that belong to those who live in the kingdom of light. – **LB**

**Verse 13:**

Who delivered [rescued, saved] us out of the authority [jurisdiction, dominion, power] of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of the Son of His love. – **TL**

He has delivered us from the control of the power of darkness and qualified us for the kingdom of light. – **CW**

He rescued us from the power of darkness, and re-established us in the kingdom of his beloved son. – **PHI**

He has released us from the confusion and meaninglessness of a closed life and has opened us up so that we participate in the authority of his Son. – **JOHN**

God...has put us into the holy nation of His much-loved Son. – **NL**

**1 Thessalonians 5:23**

**“And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.” - KJ**

May the God of peace set you apart for Himself. May every part of you be set apart for God. May your spirit and your soul and your body be kept complete... - **NL**

...And we're praying that your spirit, soul and body will be kept in perfect condition in every respect... - **AND**

...May your...very body, be preserved unimpaired, so as to be found flawless in the Day of the Coming... - **WAY**

...may you be kept, spirit, soul, and body, without loss or blame... - **WOOD**

...May every part of your being...be preserved blameless... - **K&L**

### **Hebrews 13:9**

**“For it is a good thing that the heart be established with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein.” – KJ**

Do not let all kinds of strange teachings lead you into the wrong way. Your hearts should be strengthened by God’s grace, not by obeying rules about foods, which do not help those who obey them. – **NCV**

Don’t get carried away by all kinds of crackpot ideas. It is better to nourish your heart on grace than your body on “health foods,” which bring little benefit to those who use them. – **CP**

...It is better to receive strength from God’s undeserved kindness than to depend on certain foods. After all, these foods don’t really help the people who eat them. – **CEV**

...well is it for you that your heart be fast anchored on God’s grace, not fettered to a code of clean and unclean meats. People who have made these the study of their life have gained no benefit from them. – **WAY**

...It is by God’ grace that our hearts are made strong. Nobody wins God’s favor by obeying rules about what food to eat. – **LAU**

...Our hearts are made strong by God’s gracious love, not by food. Special foods haven’t helped the people who make rules about them. – **IEB**

...Our hearts are made strong by God's loving-favor. Food does not make our hearts strong... - **NL**

...the grace of Christ is the only good ground for life... - **MESS**

### **III John 2**

**“Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.” - KJ**

My dear one, above all else I pray that you are doing well and are in good health, the same as you are doing spiritually. – **CP**

Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in every way and that your body may keep well, even as I know your soul keeps well and prospers. – **AMP**

...I pray that everything may go well with you and that you may be in good health – as I know you are well in spirit. – **GN**

...I am praying that you will be prospering, and that you will be continually having good health... – **WUEST**

Dear friend, I pray that you're doing well in every way and are also healthy... – **BECK**

...and that your health is good. – **NCV**

...I pray that your body is strong and well... – **NL**
